

# ATLANTIC COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

## **Library Collections Overview**

The Society's Library contains an extensive collection of documents, books, images, Family Bibles, ledgers, newspapers, etc. pertaining to local families. Records begin with the first settlement of Gloucester County to the division to the Atlantic County, in 1837, up to the present date.

The manuscript collection contains over 2000 original and certified copies of early documents. This collection has been entered on a DocStar computer system for easy research and copying.

Family Bible records have been copied and bound for open shelf use. The contents of collection boxes are catalogued and a reference notebook has been created. The card catalogue contains over 85,000 references.

The library's extensive image collection of daguerreotypes, lantern slides, glass plate negatives, family albums, photo scrapbooks and prints are available for researchers to view. The Society has an image fee and reproduction policy.

Other research materials within the library include newspapers (1860's to present), city directories, obituaries file, scrapbooks, census records, early vital statistics and an extensive library shelf list.

The library is open to the public. There is a modest research fee for non-members. Volunteers are on duty to assist researchers.
